

Bridgewater Dock Box Rule

One Dock Box may be installed on the main dock adjacent to the utility pedestal serving a slip. Such dock box is factory-built fiberglass, white and of standard height and depth not exceeding 26 inches in height and 24 inches in depth. The length must be a minimum of 72 inches and a maximum of 96 inches. Home built storage containers are not allowed. Dock boxes shall be secured to the dock with adequate strength marine grade stainless lag bolts or bolts on the inside of the box. At least 4 bolts must be used with the back edge of the box secured with lag bolts to the underlying stringer under the dock. If through-bolted to the dock, adequate blocking or fender washers shall be used. In the instance where a 96-inch dock box is used one dock cleat will have to be rotated 90 degrees to allow the dock box to fit. The dock board with the hole for the current cleat placement must be replaced by the slip holder.

We recommend the West Marine "Standard Marine Dock Box", 72" long or the West Marine "Fishermen's Dock Box", 96" long. This can be purchased with or without rod holders on the lid of the dock box.
