When Closing Up Your Condo for the Summer (Leave like a hurricane is coming)

As we close-up our units at the end of the season, we all need to assume there could be a hurricane. Before Irma hit SW FL, several owners who happened to be at the building had to remove furniture off lanai's and items from the front entrances of the units to prepare for the hurricane.

In the future the Association will charge unit owners who leave items on lanais (without shutters) or in hallways a fee of \$100.00 to have the items secured in the event of a hurricane. An attempt will be made to contact the owners before items are removed and you are charged.

The Association has engaged Fred Mushacke (the building handyman) and Martha Gomez to prepare the building in the case of a hurricane in the future. When you leave, please remember to:

______ Remove any items at your front door in hallway and place them inside your unit.

Such as doormats, etc.

_____ If you do not have storm shutters on your lanai all furniture must be placed inside your unit.

_____ Turn off the water.

_____ Turn off your water heater at the circuit breaker.

_____ Bikes need to be removed from bike racks.

_____ Windows closed and latched in place.

Please - Keep your air conditioner closets unlocked so there is access to the
